CHAPMAN FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

1. At least one Parent (Biological or Adoptive) must be African American or Mexican American.
2. Applicant must be a US citizen and a graduating high school Senior.
3. Applicant must have been accepted to a school of higher learning. Specifically, a College, University, or Technical Institute. Applicant needs to attach copy of acceptance letter.
4. Applicant must have maintained an overall 2.8 Grade Point Average or above during his/her high school career.
5. **Applications must be postmarked no later than June 15 of current year.** Final decisions will be made no later than August 1, or current year and will be recognized at the Chapman Products Co., Inc. Annual Ball.
6. The Scholarship will be awarded by semester---50% at the beginning of the first semester and 50% at the beginning of the second semester.
